**ORDER APPROVING RECEIVER'S APPLICATION FOR ORDER APPROVING

ADVISORS FOR RECEIVER, *NUNC PRO TUNC* TO APPOINTMENT DATE**


Upon consideration of the *Receiver's Application for Order Approving Employment of Healthcare Management Partners, LLC as Advisors for Receiver, Nunc Pro Tunc to Appointment Date* (the "*Application*");¹ and upon consideration of any and all responses, replies, and other filings with respect to the Application; and upon finding that this court has jurisdiction

over the Application and venue is proper in this court; and upon finding that due and sufficient notice of the Application has been given and no other or further notice is necessary or required; and upon due consideration of the Application and finding sufficient cause for the relief sought in the Application, it is hereby

1. **ORDERED** that the Application is GRANTED; and it is further
2. **ORDERED** that the Receiver is authorized to employ HMP, *nunc pro tunc* to January 20, 2017, the date on which the Receiver was appointed; and it is further
3. **ORDERED** that HMP shall be compensated for its services and reimbursed for reasonable expenses and costs incurred in providing such services, in accordance with the Receiver Order; and it is further
4. **ORDERED** that the Receiver shall serve a copy of this order on all parties who received notice of the Application, within three (3) business days of the entry of this order; and it is further
5. **ORDERED** that this Court shall retain jurisdiction over any and all matters arising out of this order or its implementation and enforcement.
